JURY KNOCKS OUT ATARI'S IP CLAIMS AGAINST ONLINE MARKETPLACE

Redbubble Inc, an Australia-based online marketplace successfully defended a suit by Atari Interactive Inc, third party company for Nintendo following a rejection of Atari's suit by a jury in the US Federal Court. Redbubble Inc argued it was a "transactional intermediary" which merely facilitated sales of goods fulfilled by others, and hence could not be liable for trademark infringement, among others.

THE N.I.H. SAYS IT ISN'T GIVING UP IN ITS PATENT FIGHT WITH MODERNA

PHILIP MORRIS INTERNATIONAL MEETS WITH FDA TO MAKE ITS CASE FOR IQOS IN PATENT DISPUTE

AC MILAN LOSE APPEAL FOR INTERNATIONAL TRADEMARK OF THE CLUB'S LOGO

AC Milan appealed a decision regarding the club logo not being registered as an international trademark as the term 'MILAN' had already been trademarked by a German stationery company. The similarity of the logo visually and phonetically could cause confusion, hence Milan were not able to register their trademark as the EU could not simultaneously protect them. The report notes that Milan's appeal has been rejected, which means the club will need to regroup and prepare a new strategy on this.

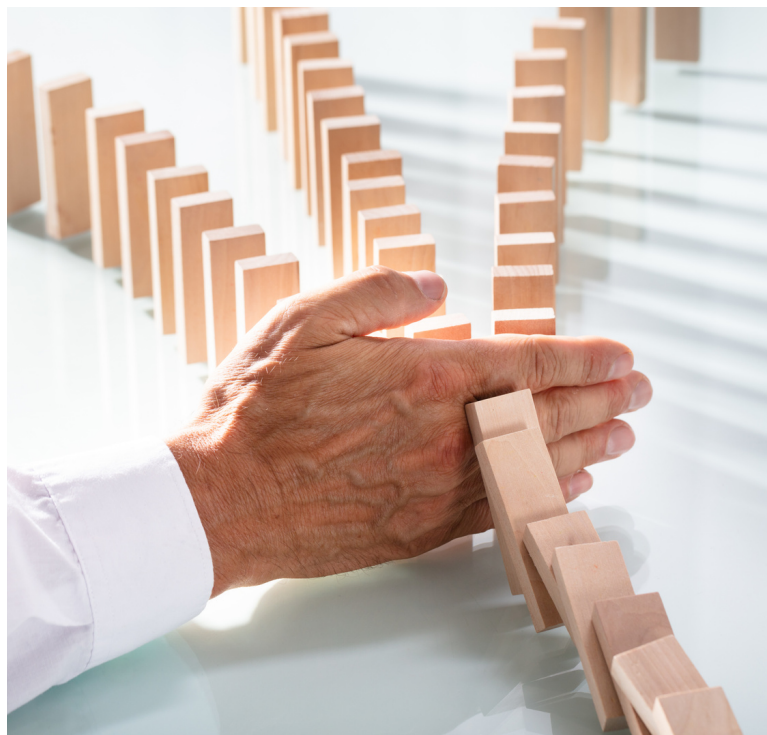
