MUSIC PUBLISHERS HAVE FILED A \$250 MILLION LAWSUIT AGAINST TWITTER FOR ALLEGED COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT

A lawsuit was filed by various music publishers against Twitter for a claim of \$250 million. The lawsuit alleges that Twitter has allowed its users to share copyrighted tunes without a licence for years and that Twitter's alleged permissiveness to the same, combined with the social network's promotion of tweets containing copyrighted music, has illegally aided the company's growth.


